

1 Peter 3:15-17

15 Your heart should **be holy and set apart** for the Lord God. Always be ready to tell everyone who asks you why you believe as you do. Be gentle as you speak and show respect.

Deuteronomy 14:2

2 You have been **set apart as holy** to the LORD your God, and He has chosen you from all the nations of the earth to be His special treasure.

2 Timothy 2:21

"Therefore, if anyone cleanses himself from these things [which are dishonorable—disobedient, sinful], he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified [**set apart** for a special purpose and], useful to the Master, prepared for every good work".

Romans 12:1-3

"When a person places faith in Jesus Christ and becomes a believer, he is sanctified—that is, **set apart for God's purpose**".

Colossians 3:12-17

"So, as God's own chosen people, who are **holy [set apart, sanctified for His purpose]** and well-beloved [by God Himself], put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience".

Jeremiah 1:1

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born, **I set you apart**; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations".

Hebrews 10:10-12

"We have been **set apart as holy** because Jesus Christ did what God wanted him to do by sacrificing his body once and for all."

1 Corinthians 6:11

"And such were some of you [before you believed]. But you were washed [by the atoning sacrifice of Christ], you were **sanctified [set apart for God, and made holy]**, you were justified [declared free of guilt] in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and the [Holy] Spirit of our God [the source of the believer's new life and changed behavior]."

1 Peter 1:16

Since it is written, "**You shall be holy, for I am holy**".

Deuteronomy 14:2

"This means living in a way that reflects our faith in God and His abounding love and kindness for every person. It means that we are marked for a purpose – to share his goodness with those around us, and to join with the Holy Spirit in what God is doing to build his kingdom on earth".



Q: What is Holy?

A: To be set apart for His purpose and glory, we must offer all we are, allowing God to make everything holy. The stickers, signs, and postcards serve as a daily reminder.

"Make it Holy" is not about Nationalism or an Evangelical agenda, neither is it a political statement. Instead, it is a reminder to place all we are onto the altar and be accountable for our sins. We should confess and repent, then give this day to the One who gives us life.

"Make it Holy" encourages us to pray for our neighbor and reach out in genuine love. Instead of offering harm, we should always represent Christ and be accountable for our actions. We have a choice to soil the day by attacking those who have differing opinions or lifestyles, cursing them, judging them, and working to destroy them. However, all of this will come back upon us, as Jesus says.

Simply put, Jesus tells us one thing to do: "Love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind... and love your neighbor as yourself."

Today is a gift - Make it Holy, set apart for God.
